The **entrance fee** of the participation is **55 euro**. Email tjonaong@gmail.com. Andrew Tjon A Ong can also arrange for you: hotel booking, transfers, excursions and even your flight ticket.

In order to organize the tournament well,

we'd like to book the participants in the Jomtien Garden Hotel. Only then we can keep the entrance fee as low as 55 euro. The costs are **app. 190 euro** per person based on a shared room for 9 nights with breakfast. If you want cheaper, more basic accommodation near the games room, you can stay in Tulip House. Indication: 130 euro per room (!) for 9 days. Prices can fluctuate, so you cannot derive any rights from the amount specified. If you want to eat or to drink in the players room, there is a waitress who takes your orders.

The **transfer Bangkok-Jomtien** is about 7 euro per person with the minibus. Excursions are, of course, not included in the price.

We recommend you to spend more days in the nice country of Thailand.
